Position Summary:

The Material Handler is responsible for the delivery of parts to welders, organization of parts being delivered from fab and daily tracking of parts in the Weld department to ensure they do not run out. This position is also responsible for production generated inventory transactions and maintaining inventory accuracy.

- Operating a forklift safely for multiple hours per day
- Receiving structural material and laser parts into weld department, verifying accuracy, quality, and sorting into build kits when needed.
